We understand that our school is a diverse community serving students with a variety of situations. The success of all children at WCE is important to the school. The backpack program will provide weekend meals to any WCE student and their immediate family members needing assistance.

To Enroll:

How it works:

The student will be assigned one rolling backpack that he/ she will pick up each Friday at the end of the school day in the front office. Backpacks will include enough non-perishable food for the weekend.

The student will return the backpack to the WCE front office on Monday morning so that it can be packed again for the following weekend.

If the backpack is lost, stolen or destroyed, the student will receive the food each week in packed grocery bags instead.

A participating family should let Westerly Creek administration know if they no longer wish to participate in the food program.
